Welcome to the 2015-2016 school year! Thank you for trusting Rockford Area Schools with your child's education! I would like to share some information with you about our EXCEL program. It's one of the ways we support the unique needs of students in grades one through eight at Rockford Elementary Arts Magnet School and Rockford Middle School – Center for Environmental Studies. The mission of the EXCEL Program is to recognize gifted and talented students and appropriately meet their unique academic, social and emotional needs, to continue Rockford Area Schools' tradition of excellence, one student at a time. We will accomplish our mission by working toward the following objectives:

- •Identify students who exhibit unique abilities or potential significantly beyond that of their peers of similar age, experience or environment
- •Provide levels of service to meet the diverse needs of highly able learners
- Enrich and extend the general education curriculum to engage and challenge highly able learners
- •Discover and nurture the unique talents and interests of individual students
- •Develop exceptional citizens who are life-long learners

The EXCEL program is built according to a levels of service model. Different opportunities are available at each grade level but all follow the same model. All EXCEL services are grounded in research-supported best practices in gifted and talented education. Services are provided both by general education teachers and the EXCEL resource teacher. Please watch for grade-level specific updates as the year progresses and we respond to student needs. I will be working closely with teachers to determine the best way to enrich and extend the education we provide at REAMS and RMS-CES.

- •Level 1: Differentiated learning opportunities and groupings in general classroom
- Level 2: Extension and enrichment opportunities throughout academic year
- Level 3: Accelerated classroom placement and talent development opportunities; mathematics and/or language arts; extra programs provided by EXCEL resource teacher
- Level 4: Separate class during WIN/BOOST time with EXCEL resource teacher; further individualization/acceleration as needed; students have demonstrated ability (in multiple ways) that is significantly above that of age-level peers.
